

PSE VIOLIN EXCERPTS 2023

To be considered for placement in the Prelude Symphonic Ensemble (PSE), prepare:

- 1) Play C major and F major scales. Student decides the number of octaves and bowing to demonstrate ability.
- 2) Play a prepared short piece or selection (no more than 2 minutes long). It does not need to be memorized.
- 3) All excerpts below following all the markings on the pages – bowings, tempo, dynamics, phrasing.
